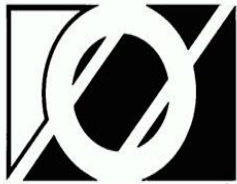

- **Professional Outreach Chair**—This team gets *pre-developed* information about OA out to local professionals like doctors, nurses, therapists, teachers, social services, etc.
- **Public Information Chair**—This team gets *pre-developed* information out to the general public and media.

Just FYI: An "Intergroup" is created when several groups in an area realize they can better perform certain functions together rather than separately. Our local Intergroup is SVIOA. It is directly responsible to the groups it serves and helps distribute information about OA to the local community. (Multiple Intergroups make up Regions and then the Regions combine to make up the [Overeaters Anonymous World Service](#). The SVIOA is in [Region II](#) which serves California, Hawaii, Mexico and Northern Nevada.)

Our SVIOA serves approximately 42+ groups in the Greater Sacramento Valley, including Roseville, Rocklin, Davis, Folsom, El Dorado Hills, Rio Linda, Natomas and West Sacramento and parts of San Joaquin County, the Northern California foothills, and Nevada City.

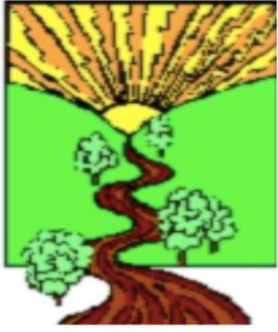
